The Lenten Journey

Ash Wednesday, February 26 (6:00pm Service):

We come to Jesus when we return to the earth.

Lent 1, March 1: The devil tempts Jesus.

Lent 2, March 8: Nicodemus approaches Jesus as a “seeker”.

Lent 3, March 15: A Samaritan woman at the well meets Jesus who offers living water.

Lent 4, March 22: A blind man seeks sight; Jesus grants him both sight and vision.

Lent 5, March 29: Martha pleads with Jesus to reverse the death of her brother Lazarus.

Palm Sunday, April 5: The parade into Jerusalem is led by a donkey.

Maundy Thursday, April 9 (7:00pm Service)

We dine with the disciples and their anxieties, needs, expectations, and desires on the night of the last supper.

Good Friday, April 10 (7:00pm Service)

We live the story of betrayal, trial, suffering and death.

Easter Sunday, April 12

(7:00am Sunrise Service, 11:00am Resurrection Service)

Mary comes to find Jesus but finds Resurrection.
